

## **Applying for My Vaccine Passes**

Vaccine passports can be applied for via the Ministry of Health website - <https://mycovidrecord.health.nz/>

If you are new to the website, you will need to sign up either through RealMe or an email address. You will need to have ID such as a drivers license or passport to register through your email.

Once signed into your My Health account, you can request your pass or certificate. Once requested this should appear in your emails within the next few minutes.

## **Downloading Pass onto an Android phone**

Make sure that the Google Pay app is installed on your phone. If not, then download the app via Play Store. **If you don't have a password or lock on your phone, you will need one in order to save your pass to Google Pay and your home screen.**

Go into the email sent with your vaccine pass and press **'G Pay Save to phone'**

Tap 'Open in Google Pay'. From here your pass will be saved to your phone. You can save this to your home screen for easier access.

## **Downloading Pass onto an iPhone**

Go into the email sent with your vaccine pass and press **'Add to Apple Wallet'**

This will then take you to a browser where you will need to press 'Add' in the top right corner.

You will now be able to access your pass via the Apple Wallet app or by double pressing the side button on newer models and the home button on older ones.
